John E. Bell, Jr., Special Agent in Charge, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Detroit, Michigan, announces the FBI is attempting to locate and identify a bank robbery suspect believed to be responsible for robbing the TCF Bank, 26838 Plymouth Road, Redford, Michigan, on February 5, 2002.

Clothing:	Cream colored knit skull cap, dark colored, fleece style three quarter length coat, and white or cream colored sweatpants
Other:	Wore prescription glasses

The suspect entered the bank, presented a demand note to the teller, and fled the bank with an undisclosed amount of cash.

A \$2000 reward is being offered for information regarding this suspect by the Detroit Clearing House Association for any information which would lead to this suspect's identity, arrest, and conviction.
