Willie T. Hulon, Special Agent in Charge (SAC), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Detroit, Michigan, has issued the following statement in response to two separate incidents this morning regarding outbound Northwest Airline flights from Detroit.

The flight from Detroit to Baltimore resulted in some of the passengers and the crew being interviewed by the Baltimore FBI upon arrival, due to some activity which took place during the flight. Based upon the results of the interviews, the passengers interviewed were released and no one was charged. There were no threats of violence to the crew or passengers which occurred during this flight.

The flight from Detroit to Mexico City was diverted for landing in Indianapolis, Indiana, when a passenger became unruly toward a flight crew member. This passenger was removed from the plane in Indianapolis, and the flight continued on to Mexico City.

SAC Hulon considers these to be two unrelated incidents and no apparent indication of any terrorist threat.
